

P R O P O S I T I O N

XII. Championship of the Fire Rescue Service of the Czech Republic in rescue of traffic accidents with international participation

1. **The organisers of the XII. FRS CZ Championship in traffic accidents recovery with international participation** ('competition') are the MoI - Directorate General of the Fire Rescue Service of the Czech Republic ('MoI-DG FRS CZ'), Kloknerova 26, 148 01 Prague 414 and the Fire Rescue Service of the Ústí Region, Horova 1340/10, 400 01 Ústí nad Labem ('FRS ULK'). The co-organisers are the Czech Association of Fire Officers, z. s. ('ČAHD'), the Sports Club of Firefighters of the Ústí nad Labem Region, z. s. and the Statutory City of Chomutov.
2. **The championship will take place on 7. – 9 October 2026 in Chomutov** in two rounds. In the first round, on 8 October 2026, the XII. HZS ČR Championship in traffic accidents recovery ('championship') will take place. In the second round on 9 October 2026, a follow-up recovery competition for traffic accidents with international participation will take place ('international competition').
3. **The championship will be attended** by one team from each region, nominated by the director of the Regional Fire Rescue Service on the basis of the results achieved in the regional progression round. **The international competition** will be attended by the winner of the championship and the team that will take second place in the championship, HZS of ŠKODA Auto, a. s., Mladá Boleslav, HZS of ČEZ a.s. and invited international teams.

6. Technical provisions

The competition will take place according to the rules of the competitions in traffic accidents rescue according to the Instruction of the General Director of the Fire Rescue Service of the Czech Republic No. 30/2025, with the following addition:

- a) The competition team consists of a commander and 3 firefighters. All team members from the Czech Republic must be members of the FRS of a region or member of an enterprise FRS of the same enterprise. The composition of the foreign teams must be in the same numerical formation, therefore, it consists of the commander and 3 firefighters and is

member of respective FRS in the sending country.

- b) The competition will be held in two rounds, according to point 2.
- c) **All tools necessary for the valid competition attempt must be placed in the CAS-type vehicle of respective team**, the power units of the aggregates are not turned on, nor are other technical devices switched on (lighting devices, etc.); **CAS is provided by each competing team themselves** (in case of a defect and for international teams, the organizer will provide a replacement CAS).
- d) The start of an attempt will be made from the CAS vehicle. The team will be sent to a pre-dedicated area before the scenario is prepared. At the request of the organizer, the team will put off the PPE. The competing team exits the insulation on the instructions of the organizer with the warning lights on without the sound device switched on. The vehicle is travelling at such a speed that its driver does not restrict or endanger the organizers, spectators and can safely stop in the designated area. The timing is triggered by the exit of the first member of the competing team from the vehicle.
- e) communication between the Intervention Commander and the 'Operational Centre' will take place via a portable radio provided by the organiser, radio operations will take place on a dedicated communication channel;
- f) interception of communication with the figurant will be provided through a speakers' setup,
- g) after the end of the intervention, the referees will carry out an analysis of the intervention in the reserved space with the competing team,
- h) the competitor will start the championship in three-layer protective emergency suit for firefighters, in protective footwear for firefighters and helmet for firefighters, without gloves, at the end of the championship the competing team will use working uniform II with caps and shoes (team always uses uniform elements of the uniform),
- i) referees will be dressed in clothing for referees rescue in traffic accidents, in protective footwear for firefighters and helmet for firefighters, for competitive trials will also be equipped with protective glasses, gloves and respirator,
- j) a total of 2 competition spaces (pits) will be prepared for the implementation of the competition; the competition attempt will be started for one competition team at a time, while the competition attempts will be carried out, the preparation of another competition team will take place, according to the drawn order.

7. General provisions

- a) Submission of applications
Applicants of the competition teams shall send duly completed and confirmed applications, including information about the competition team, to the email address <https://www.vyprostovani.hzscr.cz> by 30 September 2026 at the latest. The template for the application and the structure of the required information for the team, including multimedia information, will be published by 1 September 2026 at the latest at <https://www.vyprostovani.hzscr.cz>.
Changes can be submitted at the latest on 7 October 2026 during the team presentation and for the international competition on 8 October 2026.
- b) Professional seminar, briefing and drawing of the starting order
The professional seminar is mandatory for the competing teams and nominated referees, which will take place on 7 October 2026 at the NEXEN TIRE facility. Other participants will not be allowed to attend the seminar due to capacity reasons.

The seminar will include professional lectures, instructions on the course of the championship and drawing the starting order of the competition teams. The organizers of the seminar are the Fire Rescue Service of the Ústí nad Labem Region and ČAHD, z. s.

There is no uniform required for the seminar – suitable civilian clothing is recommended. In view of the fact that the seminar will include a visit to the NEXEN TYRE production plant, it is not possible to enter in short trousers or skirts and open shoes (sandals, slippers) with regard to OSH rules.

c) Presence and accommodation

Presence of contestants and referees at the Championships will be carried out on arrival on 7th of October 2026 from 11:00 to 12:00 at the reception at the Hotel Arena, Mostecká 5900, 43001 Chomutov.

Accommodation of competitors registered for the championship will be provided on 7th of October, accommodation of participants of the international teams on 8th October and accommodation of referees on 7th and 8th of October 2026 at the Arena Hotel, Mostecká 5900, 43001 Chomutov.

d) Accommodation, food and parking of competition teams and referees

7th of October. 2026

Food will be provided for all seminar participants in the form of coffee break and dinner during the seminar on 7. 10.

Parking of company cars, including the competition CAS, will be allowed directly in the premises of the hotel Arena, Mostecká 5900, 43001 Chomutov.

8 October. 2026

Breakfast will be provided at Hotel Arena to all accommodated participants. Lunch will be provided for all competing teams, organizers and referees at the venue of the championship at the expense of the organizer.

Dinner will be provided for participants of the international competition and referees at the Arena Hotel.

9 October. 2026

Breakfast will be provided at the Arena Hotel to all participants. Lunch will be provided for all competing teams and referees already at the venue at the expense of the organizer.

The expenses for accommodation, including catering, of the character of the dinner on 7.10.2026 and breakfast on 8.10.2026 for the competing teams of the Fire Rescue Service of the Regions shall be covered by the sending Fire Rescue Service of the Region.
